SWITZERLAND

Day 1: Zürich

We meet at airport in Zürich, from which we go to the city (private transfer), and check into the hotel. You will have 1st day free for rest or pursuing your own plans. Spending the night.

Day 2: Zürich

Breakfast. Zürich extended tour (4h). Discover why Zürich is frequently awarded "city with best quality of life" and learn about Switzerland's business and cultural center while listening to your multilingual guide pointing out the highlights of this unique town. Heading out to the beautiful surrounding area, you cross Lake Zürich by ferry and ride a cable car to Felsenegg with stunning views of the town, the lake and the snow-capped Alps.

This beautiful excursion combines the interesting city of Zürich with its beautiful nature in the surroundings. Enjoy the drive in a comfortable, air-conditioned coach passing by the castle-like National Museum, the shopping avenue Bahnhofstrasse, Zürich's famous financial district and the renowned Opera House. Photo stop at the picturesque Lake Zürich before cruising the university quarter to see the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology and Zürich's art museum. Reach the charming Old Town for your next picture stop. Introduction stroll through the pleasant pedestrian area with view of the patriarchal guild houses, St. Peter church with Europe's largest clock-face, the "Grossmünster" church and the "Fraumünster" church with the stained glass windows by Marc Chagall. Heading out of the city, the journey continues along the "Gold Coast" to Meilen where you board the ferry and cross the pristine waters of Lake of Zürich to Horgen. Move on to Adliswil for the ultimate highlight of your city tour: The ride by the only aerial cable car* in the Canton of Zürich to the viewpoint Felsenegg. This popular recreational area for the locals living in and around Zürich offers incredible views overlooking Zürich, the lake and the snow-capped Alps. Enjoy the fresh air of the beautiful forest before heading back to Zürich.

Arrival on meeting point and return on your own.



Day 3: Zürich – Rhine Falls

Breakfast. Rhine Falls. Sit back and relax on a comfortable coach while listening to your multilingual guide explaining about Switzerland's interesting history and culture. The journey takes you along the Grand Tour of Switzerland through picturesque landscape with gently rolling vineyards and charming farming villages close to the German border. Reach the first highlight of this afternoon at splendid medieval Castle Laufen – the mighty Rhine Falls! Enjoy about one hour leisure time at Europe's biggest waterfalls and one of Switzerland's major tourist attractions! Delight unique views from the panoramic lift and see how an average of 700'000 liters of water per second plunge across a width of 150 meters into the basin below. The Belvedere panoramic trail brings you to the viewing platform right above the falls where you feel the spindrift of the rumbling waters. Take an optional boat ride (summer only) close to the falls. Continue via Schaffhausen with its well-known Munot Fortress and passing through the beautiful countryside to the medieval town of Stein am Rhein. On a guided stroll, you learn about the well-preserved old town with its many distinctive buildings. Most of these half-timbered houses are made of stone with delicate wooden windows and stun visitors with their exceptional frescoes. The most prominent of these houses is the White Eagle, whose fresco counts as the oldest preserved mural painting of the Renaissance in Switzerland. After some time at leisure, drive back in the evening to Zürich. On meeting point and back on your own.

Day 4: Zürich – Lucerne & Mt. Titlis

Breakfast. Full Day Tour to Lucerne and Mt Titlis. Morning after breakfast at hotel proceed for Full day excursion to Mt. Titlis. The scenic coach journey begins through the beautiful countryside via Albis Pass and along the shores of the Lake of the Four Cantons to Lucerne. On a short City Tour you visit the Lion Monument and your guide will show you the main sights of this charming town. Enjoy some time at leisure to explore the Old Town before we continue to Engelberg. At the Valley Station the breath-taking journey with the different aerial cable cars to the top of Mt. Titlis, located on 3'000 m.a.s.l., begins. Enjoy the spectacular sight of the glacier's deep crevasses and gigantic ice boulders from the revolving cable car Rotair. At the top of Mt. Titlis a high alpine panorama awaits you. Enjoy magnificent views of the Alps from the restaurants or the sun terrace. Visit the Glacier Cave and pass over Europe's highest suspension bridge - the Cliff Walk! Take a ride with the Ice Flyer which brings you close to the crevasses and the Glacier Park where you can experience snow tubing even in summer! Descent with aerial cable cars and drive back by coach via Lucerne to Zürich. Arrival on meeting point and return on your own.



Day 5: Zürich

Breakfast. Free day. This day is left fully at your own disposal. Use it for rest, your own plans, or other forms of entertainment. Also you can meet your hosts, try some local food or drinks or pursue your own interests.

* Option 1: Grindelwald and Interlaken full day. Full-day excursion to one of Switzerland's most attractive alpine regions, the idyllic Bernese Oberland and the magnificent Jungfrau region mountain world. Valuable free time (approx. 6 hours) allows you to explore two famous mountain resorts Grindelwald, also named Eiger or Glacier Village, and Interlaken, uniquely located between two lakes.

Embark on a scenic coach journey through splendid countryside to Interlaken, the heart of the magnificent Jungfrau region. After a first orientation stop in Interlaken, we continue to Grindelwald, a lively and varied place perfect for active holidays. Numerous lookout points provide stunning views of the surrounding impressive mountain landscape including the world famous triple peaks Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau. During your leisure time, experience a cable car ride to the sunny terrace of 'Mt. First' and enjoy the 40-meter long Cliff Walk by Tissot or undertake a fun trottibike ride (available only during summer). In the afternoon, enjoy the unescorted public train ride back to Interlaken. Spend the rest of the afternoon exploring the region's shopping paradise - the choices on offer are diverse, from regional produce to precious jewelry and watches. Alternatively, visit Interlaken's home mountain Harder Kulm. A cable car takes you to the top where you will be rewarded with splendid views of the surrounding area. Full of mountain-fresh air and fond alpine memories you meet your guide again in the late afternoon for the return journey. 80 € per person

* Option 2: Jungfrauoch full day. Don't miss the highlight of any Swiss holiday and join us for this thrilling and unforgettable full-day excursion to Jungfrauoch – Top of Europe! Listed by UNESCO as "World Heritage Site of the Swiss Alps" it is home to Europe's highest train station (3500 m) and many other attractions!

A scenic coach journey through splendid countryside takes you to the Bernese Oberland. After a break in Interlaken, a picturesque village nestled idyllically between Lakes Brienz and Thun, board the cogwheel train in Grindelwald for a spectacular ride via Kleine Scheidegg up to Jungfrauoch. Stunning views of the world-famous triple peaks of Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau accompany you on the way and the imposing Eiger North Face seems to be within one's grasp. Once on the top, immerse yourself in the fascinating high alpine wonderland of eternal ice, snow and rock. Experience the adventure tour "Alpine Sensation"

marking the 100-year anniversary of the Jungfrau Railway and visit the Sphinx Observation Terrace and Plateau with the most breath-taking panoramic views of snow-capped peaks, the neighboring countries and Europe's longest glacier, the Aletsch Glacier. Don't forget to stroll through the tunnels of the Ice Palace located in the heart of the glacier – a once in a lifetime experience not to be missed! Restaurants are available for meals and refreshments. The descent passes car-free holiday destination Wengen and takes you to Lauterbrunnen, where the coach awaits you for the return trip. 215 € per person
